BLEPHAROCONJUNCTIVITIS

Blepharoconjunctivitis is an inflammation of three tissues of the eye, the edge or margins of the eyelid, the transparent membrane that covers the outer white part of the eye, the conjunctiva, and the inner underside tissue of the eyelids. This inflammation of these tissues may be caused by bacteria, virus, or allergy.

Symptoms generally include a mucus-like discharge (eyelids sticking together), redness, burning and a foreign body sensation. Specific treatment depends on the cause of the inflammation. Pay close attention to my recommended treatment plan and to any prolonged or additional symptoms that may arise.
