### **CORNEAL ABRASION**

A corneal abrasion is a loss of superficial tissue from the front surface of the eye. This may result from a scratch or a scrape of the corneal surface. Typically, corneal abrasions are associated with light sensitivity, a sensation that there is something in the eye, as well as increased tearing.

Corneal abrasion may cause mild discomfort or severe pain, depending on the severity of the lesion. Treatment may include lubrication, eye patching, preventative antibiotic ointment, and in some cases a protective bandage contact lens.

Since the cornea is the fastest healing tissue in the human body, most corneal abrasions will heal within 24-36 hours. Call my office if symptoms do not lessen beyond the first 36 hours.
