Corneal epithelial dystrophies are disorders involving the outermost layer of the front portion of the eye, the cornea. These dystrophies may result in decreased vision due to corneal cloudiness, and surface irregularities on the cornea. When epithelial dystrophies result in open lesions of the front surface of the cornea, the condition may become very painful. These lesions or erosions may become recurrent. Approximately 50% of all corneal epithelial dystrophies are hereditary in nature.
